On the day following collection week, we set out all the supplies on tables in one of our meeting rooms. People who dropped off supplies receive a ticket for the "early shopping day." On the day following setup, ticket holders (only) shop the entire swap for free. The next day, and the following several days (however long we can book the meeting room for, usually 3-5 days) the swap is open to the rest of the public. All items are free. No limits are imposed.
