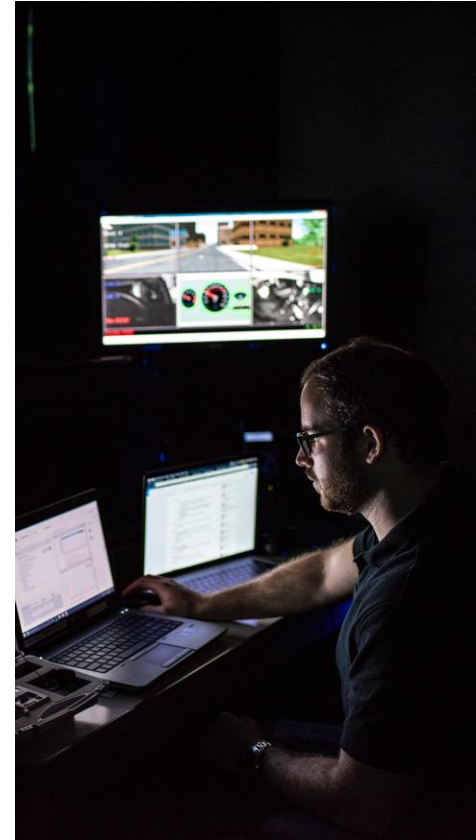

# MSI Program

- An open, information-centered program to advance library workers' careers to the next level
- Starting in Fall of 2024, program is structured around an introductory course, electives, and a professional project
- Allows for choice of wide range of electives that allow students to explore interests, while also choosing courses from any of UMSI's top-ranked focus areas
- Program retains focus on functional areas of librarianship, centered around a collections concept:
  - Managing and Sustaining Collections
  - Representing and Sharing Information
  - Connecting Information and Communities
  - Digital Curation

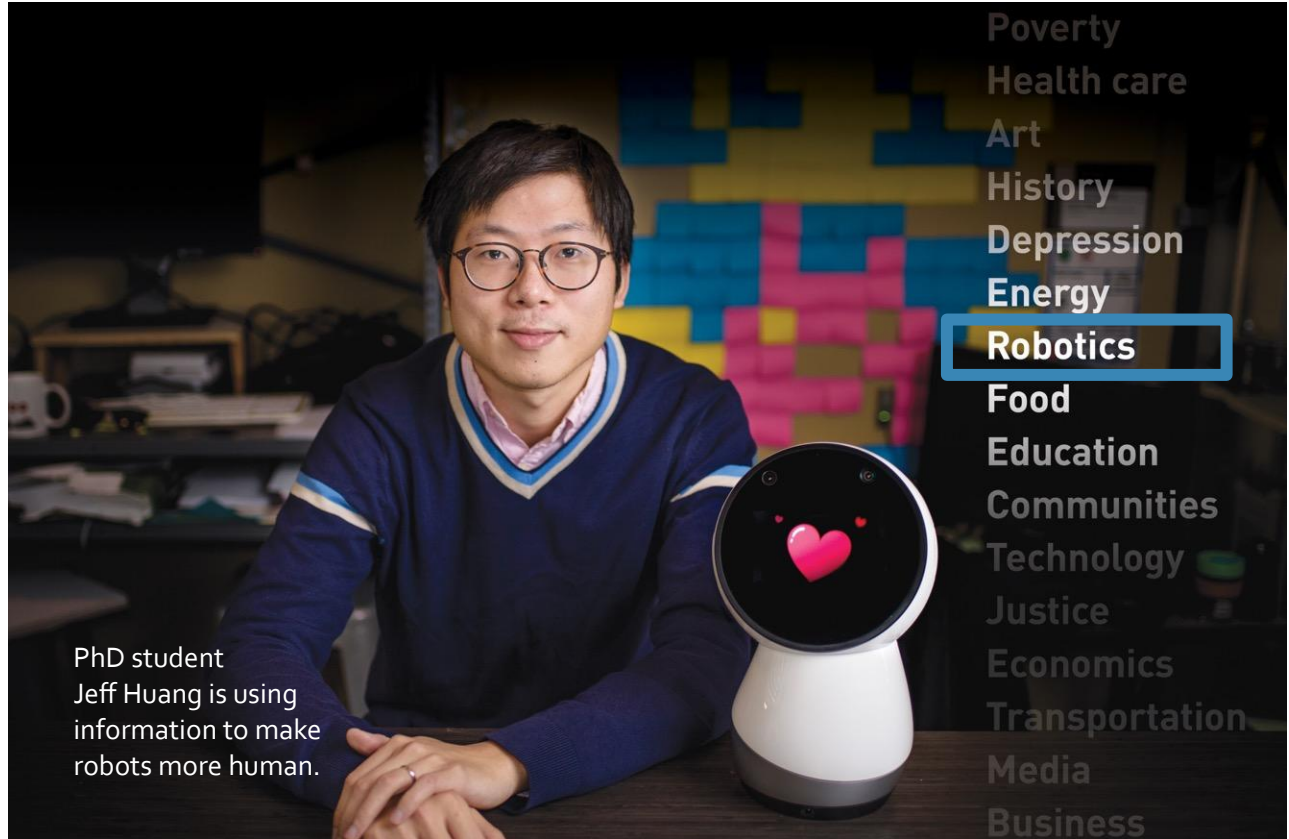

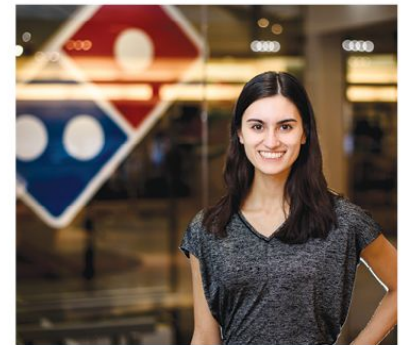

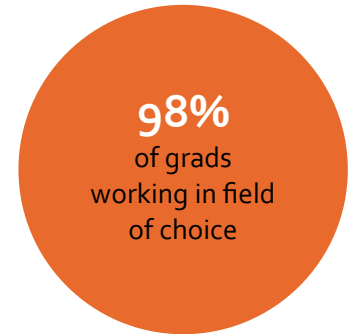
