

MLA FAQ's

Q1. Do I have to be a member to register for an MLA event?

- No, but if you'd like to save 50% on all registration costs, it pays to be an MLA member.

Q2. Is my library an MLA Organizational member?

- There are a couple ways to find out. You can visit the MLA website and search for your library. If your library's contact information is listed on the [MLA website directory](#), then they are an MLA Organizational Member
- This means you can join MLA as an Affiliated Individual Member at \$85 annually

Q3. Can I register under my organization's account?

- **NO!** You must register under your own personal MLA account. Each MLA member has their own membership profile with their unique username and password
- If you need help identifying if you or your [organization](#) has an account - **See Q2 or Q4**

Q4. Do I have an Individual MLA membership?

- Go to the MLA website at www.mlibraries.org
- Click the **Member Login box** – enter your username and password
- If you forgot your username or password the links (retrieve username) or (retrieve password) can help retrieve them for you
- If your [username](#) and/or [password](#) don't work, more than likely you do not have an account
