First Session

Families are welcomed and receive program entry surveys in a welcome packet. Today's stories are those from the oral tradition chosen by the storyteller/scholar. Our first sessions included a version of *The Three Little Pigs* and *Aesop's Fables*. Stories and discussion time are shorter for the first session.

Parents should actively participate in the activities. Volunteers clean up dinner.
6:10 p.m. – 6:55 p.m. – Storytellers read stories and scholars lead children in a discussion about each book. The books for next week are previewed.
6:55 p.m. – Distribute free books and door prizes.
