- VDL -
  - Story Time caregivers could pick up 4 weeks of crafts associated with each weeks' story time. Plus a bag with scarf, shaker, crayons and glue stick for first time families.
  - Teen Take Home (better "attended" than in person programs!) Mini-Zen garden and Sharpie Mug

#### To Go Kits





- KPL KPL@Home and Teen Takeout
- PPDLTeen Take-Home/Break the Stress, Take & Make, Pre-k Curiosity Kits
  - Break the Stress Boxes: Monthly theme with book lists and activities
    - Boxes returned and reused to save cost
  - Teen Take-Home: Bi-Monthly once we fully reopened library with no in person programs
    - Used DVD cases to package items since we had a bunch
  - Adult Take & Make and Pre-K Curiosity Kits are still monthly
- VDL
  - First COVID summer I had take home bags for story time, craft kits for elementary and craft kits for teens.

  - Paint & Sip Using YouTube instead of in person instructor



• Book bundles during different season. Box would have 2-3 books of a specific genre and fun snacks/treats/stickers that would match theme. I would copy the barcode of the book and put it on a card on the outside of the box. Boxes were tied shut so books couldn't be peeked at OR taken out and traded. Books had to be returned, but the treats were their's to keep.
