

# Not-So-Scary Haunted House Props

## Floating Bottle

**Supplies:** 8-12 inch plastic cauldron, water pump, glass straw with a bend in it, plastic bottle or jar, “mist maker,” clear Gorilla glue, and green food coloring.

## Witchy Cookbooks

**Supplies:** Withdrawn hardcovers, craft paint, and paintbrushes.

**Instructions:**

1. Remove the dust jacket.
2. Paint the spine a solid color.
3. Add a new witchy title, either with paint or cut out vinyl letters.
4. Take brown craft paint, water it down, and cover the exposed edges of the pages. Allow to dry completely.



## Tombstones

**Supplies:** Cardboard, craft paint, paintbrushes, sand weights, and optional vinyl/paper cut letters.

**Instructions:**

1. Cut the shape out of the cardboard.
2. Paint the cardboard grey.
3. Either paint the letters on or attach the precut letters.
4. Use additional cardboard behind to make a “kickstand” to prop it up.



5. Use bagged or bottled sand to hold it in place.

10 parts water

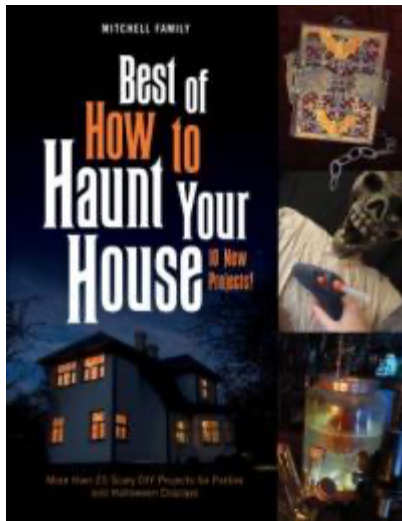
6 parts flour
